

Registration Agreement for Parents and Players

Parents' Code of Conduct

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and abusive or inappropriate language, and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will remember that the game is for youth—not for adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials, with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
- I will consider supporting the league by agreeing to volunteer for a minimum of one (1) hour each season.
- I will respect and obey the guidelines of the South Carolina United YMCA Recreational Youth Soccer League.
- I will ensure that my guests / visitors to South Carolina United FC or YMCA events also respect the guidelines of this code.
- I will NOT bring pets to the fields for practices or games. NO PETS are allowed on the fields during practices or games.

Accident/Injury Liability Release

Recognizing the possibility of physical injury and other damages associated with participation in youth soccer and in consideration for the SCUYMCA Recreational Youth Soccer League ("The League") accepting your child as a registrant to participate in The League and its activities (together "The Program") pursuant to the terms and permissions granted in this Application form, on behalf of my child, myself, my spouse and my/our heirs, I do hereby release and agree to hold harmless and indemnify South Carolina United FC, the YMCA of Columbia and its branches, the South Carolina Youth Soccer Association and the United States Youth Soccer Association, and each of these entities' employees, volunteers, officers, board members and the owners of fields and facilities utilized for The Program from and against any and all claims made by or on behalf of my child for injury, damages and/or other relief in contract, tort or otherwise arising out of my child's participation in The Program and/or being transported to or from activities of The Program, which transportation I hereby authorize. My child has received a physical examination by a physician and has been found physically capable of participating in The Program.

Photo and Media Promotional Permission

AS A TERM AND CONDITION of registering myself as a coach or volunteer or my child as a participant in any one or more of the Recreational, Pre-Academy, Jr. Academy, Select youth or adult soccer programs, including but not limited to leagues, camps, trainings, tournaments, events or cultural exchanges (hereinafter "SCUFC soccer programming"), whenever and wherever occurring which are owned by, operated by, managed by or affiliated with South Carolina United FC, the Columbia YMCA, South Carolina Youth Soccer, US Club Soccer or the United States Soccer Federation, IT IS EXPRESSLY UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that I hereby (a) grant South Carolina United FC (hereinafter, "Club") and the Columbia YMCA, and their respective representatives, employees and vendors the right to take photographs of me or my child in connection with either one of our, or both of our, respective participation in SCUFC soccer programming and (b) authorize the Club and/or the Columbia YMCA and their respective assigns and transferees to copyright, use and publish without any compensation whatsoever any such photographs in print and/or electronic formats with or without our respective names included therewith for any lawful purpose, including for example such purposes as publicity, illustration, advertising, promotion and Web and other Social Media content and usage.

Richland County Disclaimer

This is not a Richland County Recreation Commission (RCRC) run program and RCRC is not responsible for any financial obligation incurred by the league.

Recreational Camp Medical Release

I, as a parent or legal guardian of the player, hereby give my permission for South Carolina United FC or YMCA Staff to procure necessary medical treatment, until such time as I may be contacted, for my child/ward should they be injured or require medical attention while playing or practicing as members of South Carolina United FC or Columbia United YMCA Recreational Soccer. This permission shall be in effect for one year from date of signing.

I, as a parent or legal guardian of the camper, understand that soccer is an active, physical sport, and that injuries can take place during play. I also do hereby assume responsibility for any accident injury or death that may occur while my child/ward is participating in any event sanctioned by South Carolina United FC or SCUYMCA Recreational Soccer. I for ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge South Carolina United FC's or Columbia United YMCA's Summer Camp and its staff, officers, agents, employees, representatives, successors and assign of and from all rights and claims for injury which may be sustained or occur during participation in Camp activities or while at Camp.

Note: Camp Refunds will only be issued if requested in writing at least 7 days prior to the camp start date. All refund requests must be sent to camps@southcarolinaunitedfc.com. All refund requests must be sent to .

Refund requests due to illness require a doctor's note and must be submitted before the last day of camp in order to qualify for a camp refund

Recreational Refund Policy

No refund requests will be honored after September 1 for the Fall Recreational Soccer Season or February 1, for the Spring Recreational Soccer Season. The only exception will be for season-ending injuries or family relocation out of the Columbia area.

When possible, we will attempt to assign players to different teams to resolve personal schedule conflicts. Refunds on the basis of schedule conflicts or coaching preferences will not be honored. All refunds are subject to a \$25 administrative fee.

All refund requests must be sent via e-mail to the SCUYMCA Recreational League Registrar and MUST include a reason for refund. Please e-mail request to SCUYMCA@southcarolinaunitedfc.com.

NO REFUNDS AFTER SEPTEMBER 1 FOR THE FALL RECREATIONAL SEASON OR FEBRUARY 1 FOR THE SPRING RECREATIONAL SEASON.

NO REFUNDS FOR RECREATIONAL CAMPS UNLESS REQUESTED 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE CAMP START DATE.
